

**IRB Inquiry Form

Any NIU graduate student who proposes to undertake research involving human subjects, animal subjects, or recombinant DNA is required to obtain university approval for the project **before the data collection phase begins**. Forms requesting approval for such research may be obtained from most departmental offices or from the Office of Research Compliance. A thesis/dissertation will not be reviewed until all necessary approvals are on file in the Graduate School.

The inquiry form, submission of which clears a milestone in the Degree Progress Report, is designed to ensure that students and mentors consider IRB requirements early, and it permits the Graduate School to monitor compliance. The form should be submitted immediately after a thesis/dissertation topic receives formal approval.
